Here are some examples:

- **\$10 a month** will provide ten smoke alarms for people that need them.
- **\$14** will provide a week of delivered meals and home visits to a homebound senior.
- **\$7.32 per week** will provide six weeks of counseling for a low income person.
- **\$40** will provide a low-income child with a week of after school care, homework help and healthy snacks.
- **\$1 a week** will provide a day of transportation to homeless people to and from the emergency shelters.
- **\$10 a month** provides a caregiver of a person with Alzheimer’s disease access to education programming and monthly caregiver support groups.
